## YES TO A CAMPUS FOR MUSIC EDUCATION

- > A single location for the **Haute école de musique** (HEM), the only college currently dispersed over 7 inadequate sites.
- > A place open to everyone and to the Canton's schools for events **and educational activities**.



## YES TO MORE CULTURE FOR GENEVA

- > A **residence with sufficient infrastructure** for the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande (OSR).
- > A **place of expression** open to all forms of music for local artists.
- > A **place of cultural interaction** and creativity for a diverse range of artistic disciplines.

## YES TO A PLACE OPEN TO EVERYONE

- > A place for the people of **Geneva**, the wider lake region, **Greater Geneva**, as well as Swiss and foreign tourists.
- > A forum welcoming people of **all ages and walks of life**, including those with disabilities.
- > A place open to **local performers** and all music and art forms.

## YES TO A SELF-SUPPORTED, SUSTAINABLE PROJECT

- > A **gift to the population**: building construction and park layout costs 100% funded by sponsors and by the Confederation (for building sections dedicated to HEM).
- > **CHF 0.00 cost to taxpayers**: operating costs managed by the HEM and OSR from their current budgets and from rental income from the space.
- > A possible contribution from the Canton would enable the opening of the programming to local performers.

## YES TO A NEW PLACE FOR ENTERTAINMENT AND LEISURE AT NATIONS

- > **New park with greenery and biodiversity** on a private site currently closed to the public.
- > **Library, cafeteria & restaurant** open daily, **concert halls, exhibition, and activity rooms**.

## YES TO AN ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY PROJECT

- > Preservation of the **forest** and century-old oak trees (**2 new trees** planted for every tree removed).
- > **Rainwater harvesting**, rooftop solar panels, and connection to the GeniLac renewable energy system.
- > **Access via all means of transport**: tram, train, road (car park), bicycle (parking for 320 bikes), pedestrian walkways.
